# Vessel & Barges Streamlined Contingency Plans Webinar for Plan Holders

The Regulations and Guidance Group of the Prevention, Preparedness, and Response Program will be hosting a webinar on **December 9, 2020 from 10:30 – 11:30 a.m.** Alaska Standard Time. The goal is to familiarize interested stakeholders with recent amendments to the Oil Discharge Prevention and Contingency Plan regulations under 18 AAC 75. The amendment allows noncrude oil tank vessels and barges with a total storage capacity of less than 500 barrels to apply for a streamlined plan.
