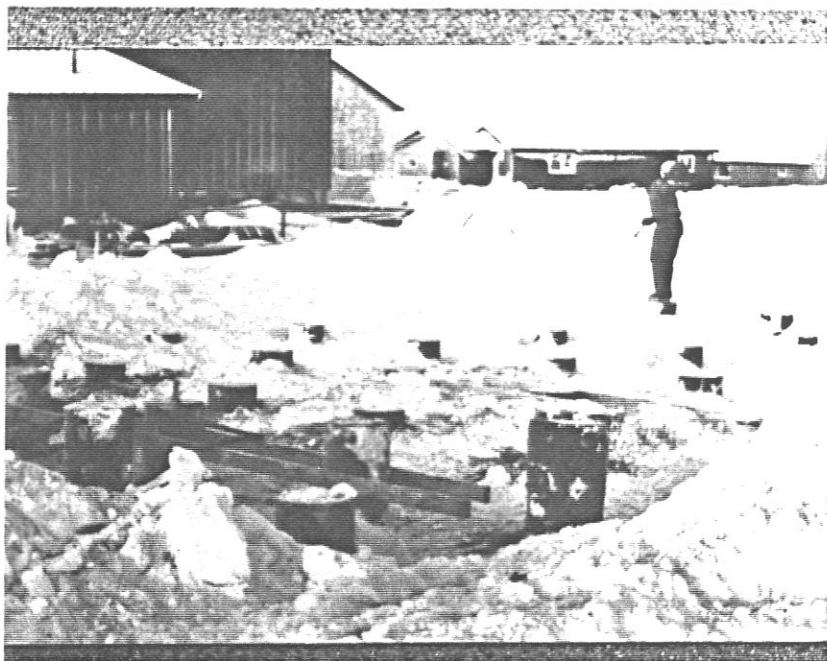

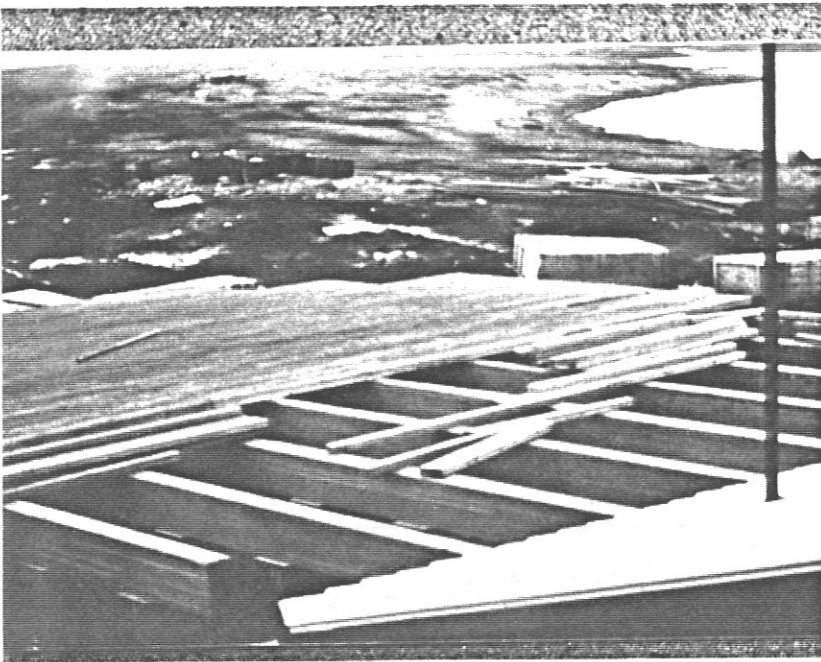

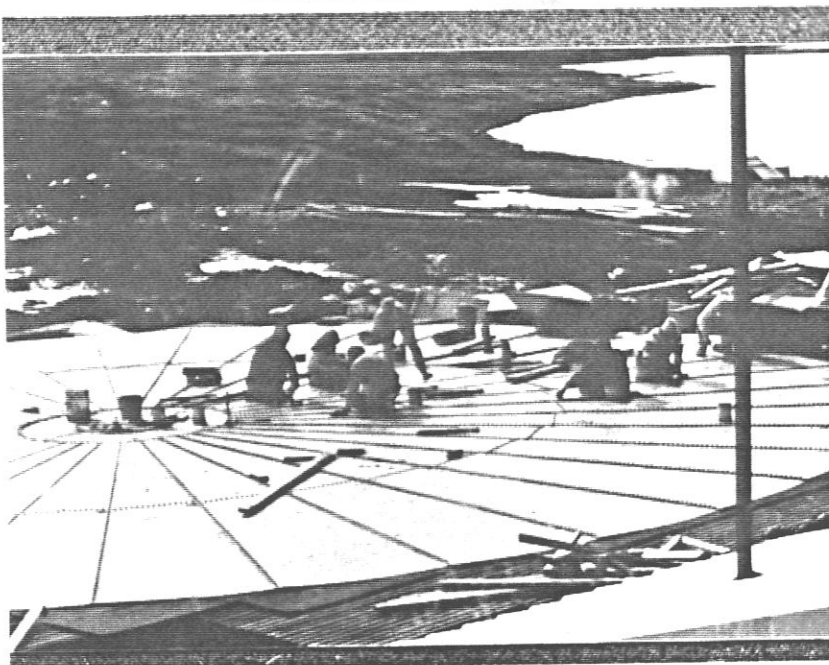

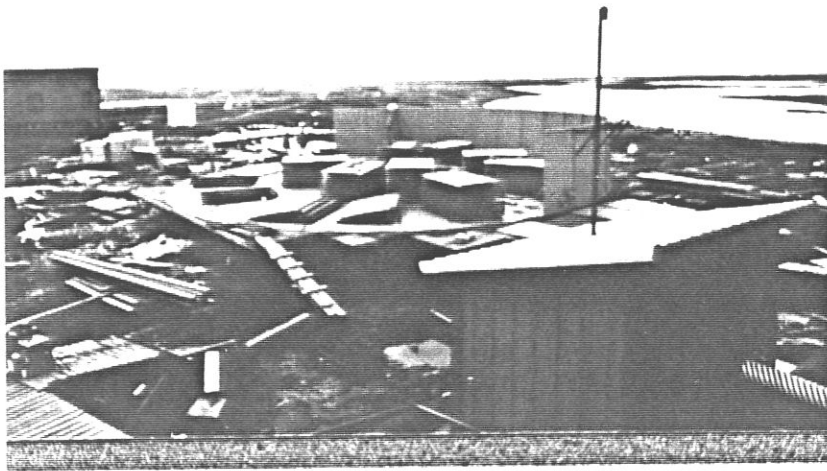

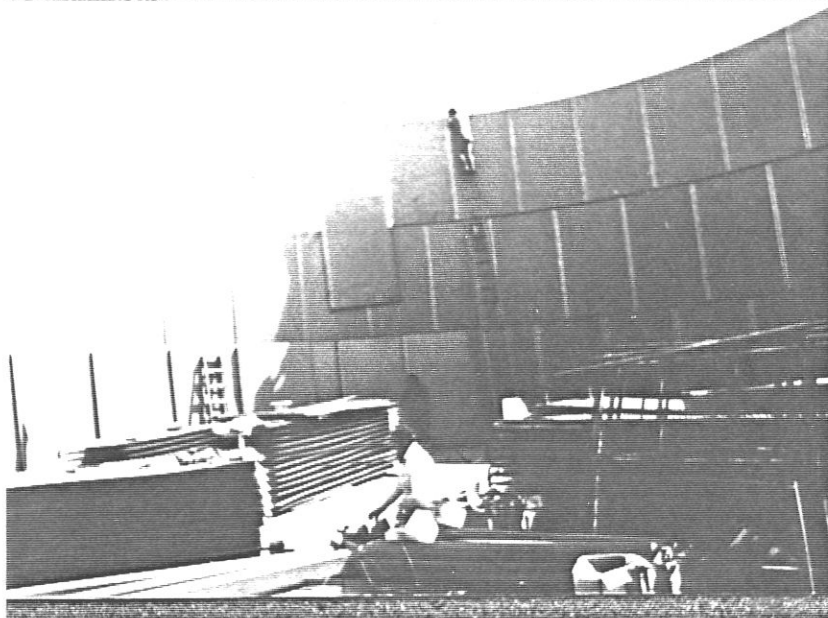

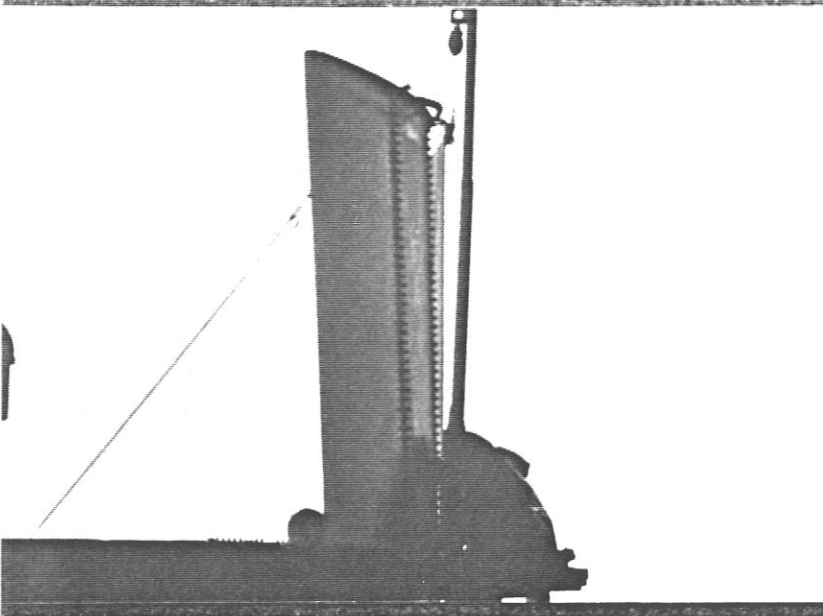

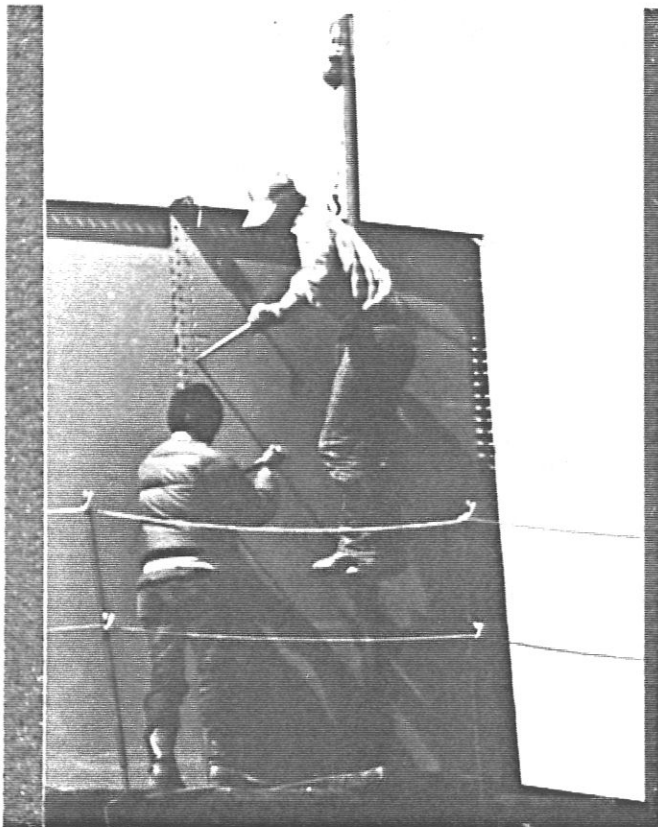
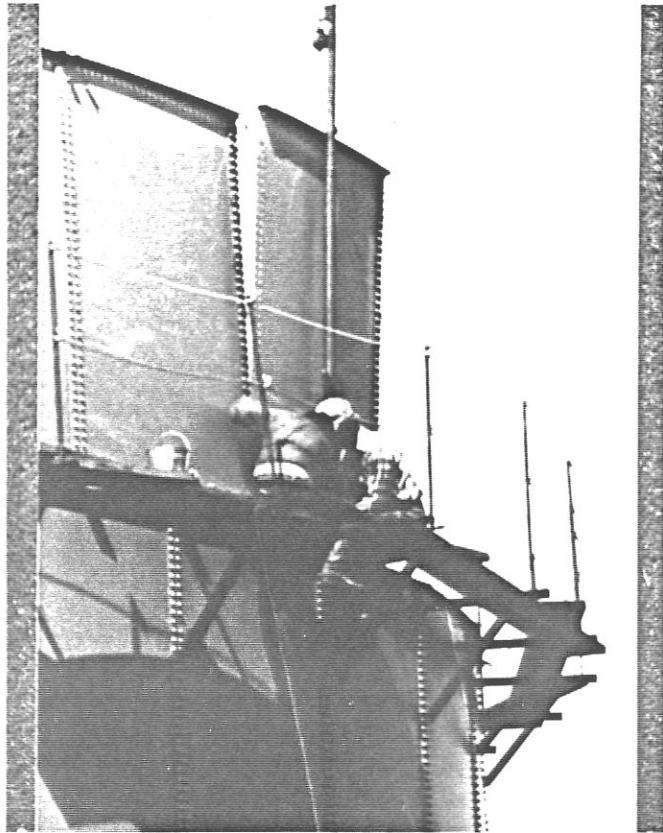

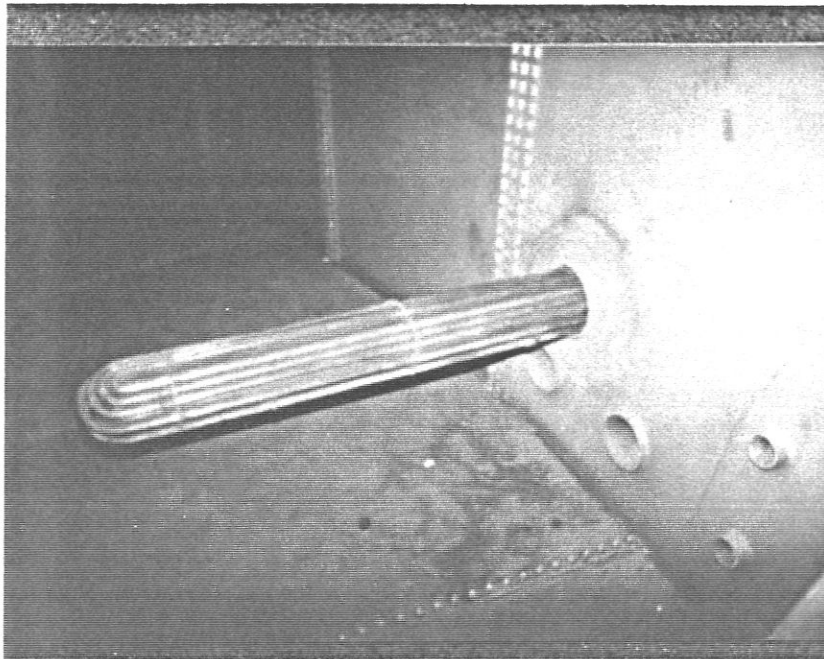


GIN POLE

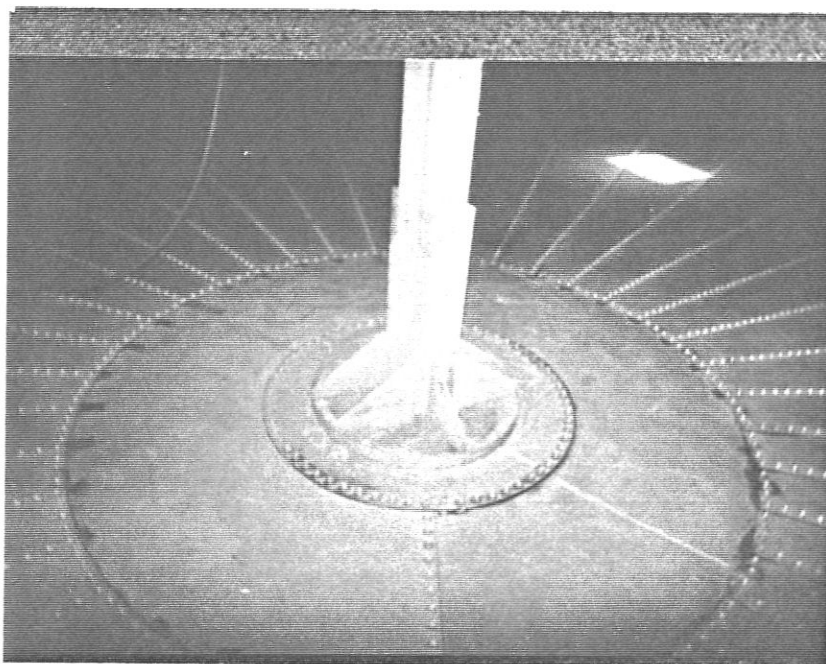


LINING UP THE

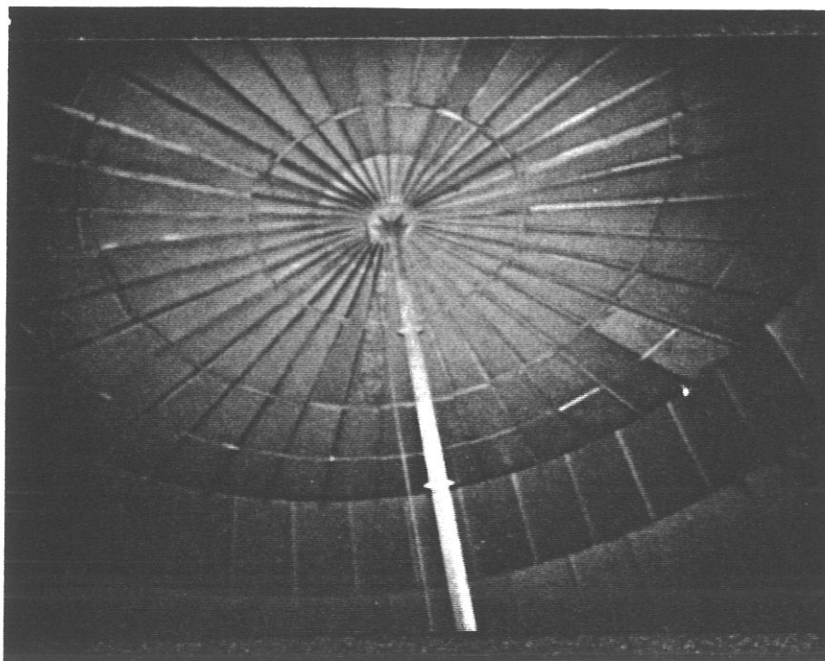




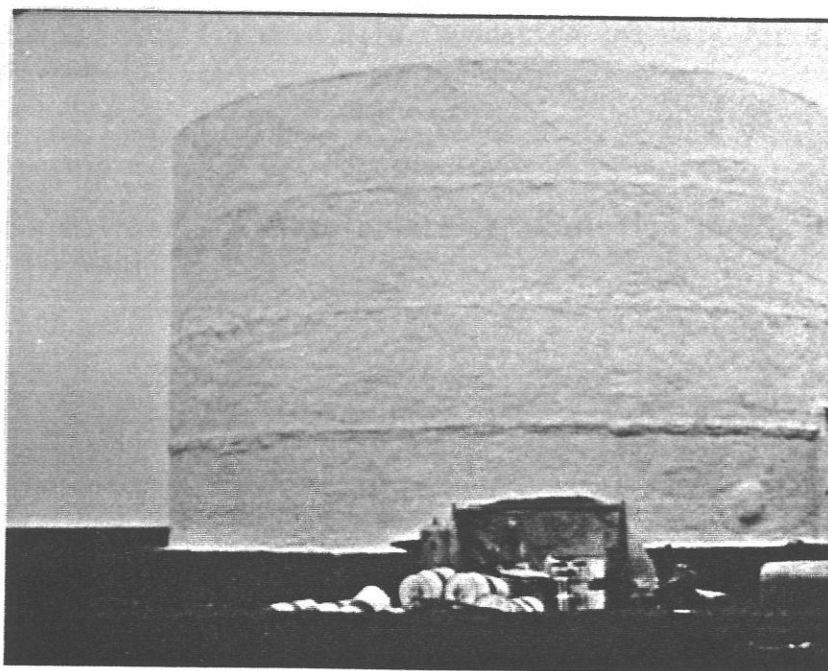
HEAT EXCHANGER IN TANK

Dear Mr. Azean:

The 1981 legislature appropriated \$485,000 to improve the water supply for the Kongiganak Village Safe Water Facility. Under the provisions of AS 46.07 (the Village Safe Water Act) the Department of Environmental Conservation offers your corporation a grant of \$485,000 for the water source improvement project.

The project will consist of the following:

1. Furnish and install a wood pile foundation and deck for a water storage tank.
2. Furnish and install an insulated water storage tank of approximately 570,000 gallon capacity.
3. Furnish and install a plastic water transmission line from a lake to the VSW facility.
4. Modify the water treatment equipment to provide optimum treatment of the water from the new source.
5. Construct a storage building at the lake for the pumping equipment and supplies.

Your acceptance of the grant is subject to the following conditions:

1. The Safe Water Corporation will maintain a bank account for the construction project. This account will be kept separate for accounting procedures and it shall have the following persons as authorized signatories, two of which can authorize a check:

Evon Azean, Dick Kiunya, Ralph Kiunya, Sherman Igkurak and Edmund Jacobsen.

2. The Corporation designates Edmund S. Jacobsen, the VSW Engineer, or his designee as its representative in the administration of the project and in requesting payments under this grant agreement.

3. The Corporation agrees to obtain all titles and easements necessary to provide clear title needed to construct and maintain the proposed facilities.
4. The Corporation acknowledges that the State is serving only as a funding source for this project and, as such, is to be held harmless by the Corporation for any claims or damage arising as a result of this VSW grant assisted project.
5. The Corporation acknowledges the right of the State to rescind the grant and seek recovery of payments already made on the project if payment requests contain incorrect or misleading information, or if a grant condition contained herein is violated.
6. Final engineering plans for construction activities funded by the VSW grant must be reviewed and approved by this Department before construction begins.

If you wish to accept this VSW grant offer subject to the above grant conditions, please so indicate by appropriate signature at the end of this letter and return it to me.



We have been successful in reprogramming some funds to cover the expected overrun in construction of the improvements to the Kongiganak Safe Water Facility. Under the provisions of AS 46.07 (the Village Safe Water Act) the Department of Environmental Conservation offers your corporation a grant of \$46,968.52 for the water source improvement project.

Work items included in the project are the following:

1. Construction of a wood pile foundation and deck for a water storage tank.
2. Erection and insulation of a 570,000 gallon water storage tank.
3. Installation of a plastic water transmission line from a lake to the VSW facility, and modification of plumbing.
4. Furnishing a storage building at the lake for the pumping equipment and supplies.


