

State Emergency Operations Center








State Oil & HazMat Response Organization

When releases are part of a State Declared Disaster/Emergency


- State Emergency Operations

Transition to Stafford Act/Federal Disaster and ESF-10


- Most Presidential Disasters in Alaska are for recovery, not response.
- Alaska rarely requests "Direct Federal Assistance" for ESF-10 activities.
- Alaska DEC remains the lead agency through transition to a Joint Field Office








Joint Field Office/ESF-10 Operations








Joint Field Office/ESF-10 Operations




- Alaska DEC leads ESF-10 mission/desk
- USCG, EPA, Other Federal Agencies respond according to Alaska DEC and State Coordinating Officer priorities.


