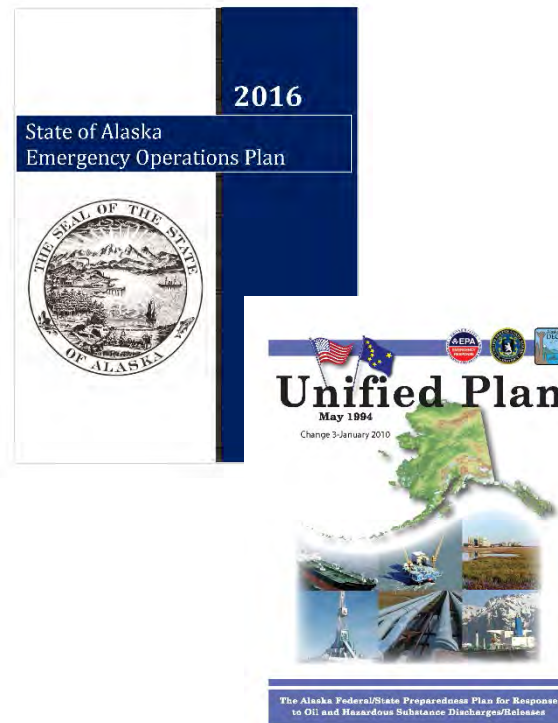

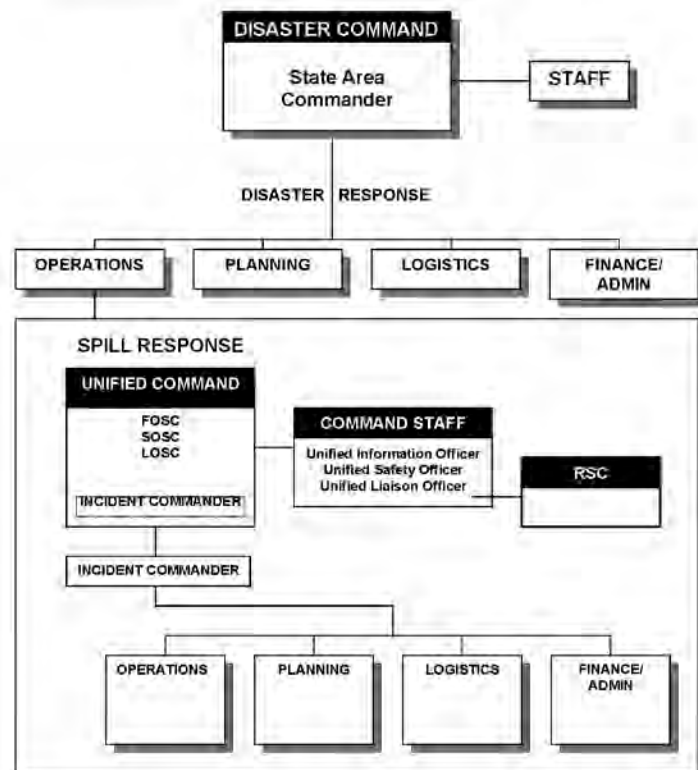


State Oil & HazMat Response Organization

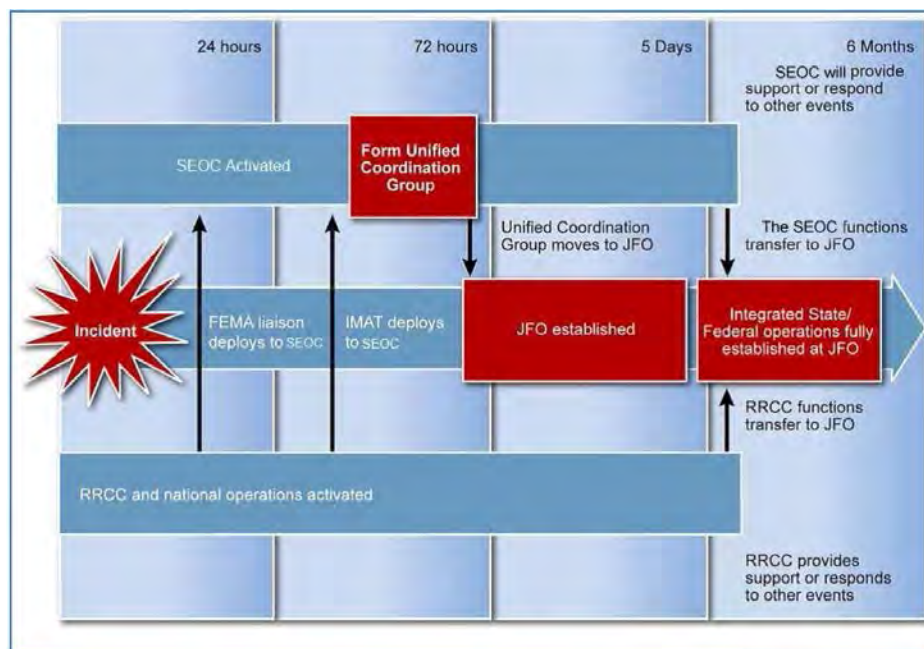
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Transition to Stafford Act/Federal Disaster and ESF-10

- Most Presidential Disasters in Alaska are for recovery, not response.
- Alaska rarely requests “Direct Federal Assistance” for ESF-10 activities.
- Alaska DEC remains the lead agency through transition to a Joint Field Office

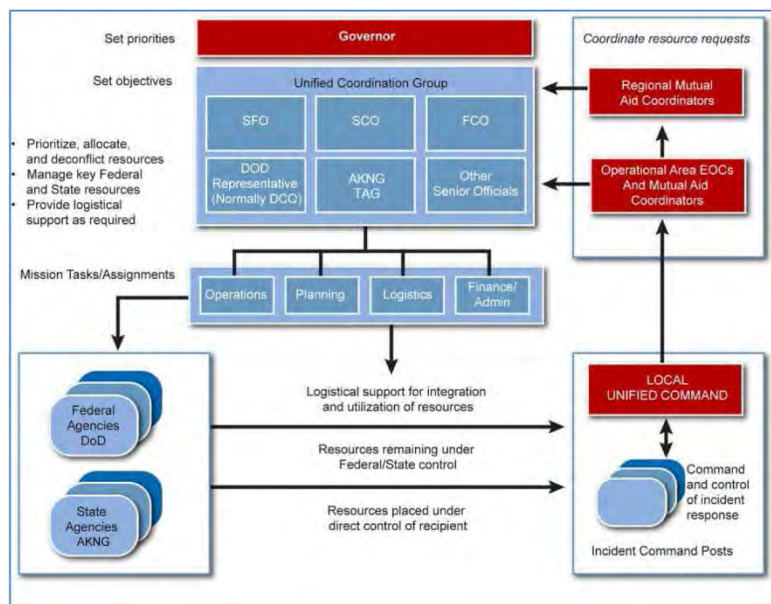
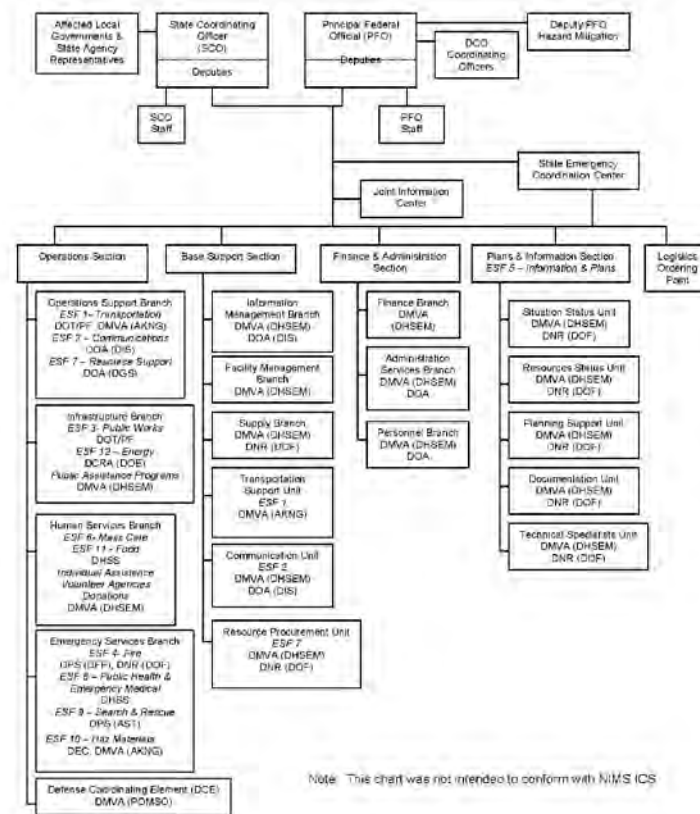


Figure 11: Spills Resulting From Natural Disasters That Have a Presidential Disaster Declaration

- USCG, EPA, Other Federal Agencies respond according to Alaska DEC and State Coordinating Officer priorities.

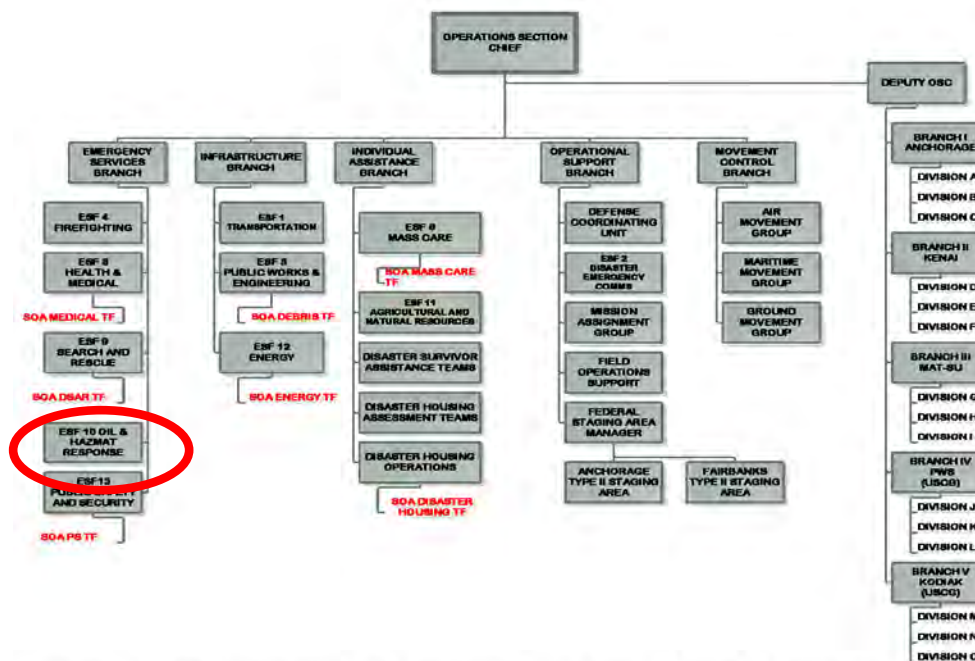
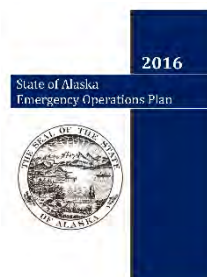
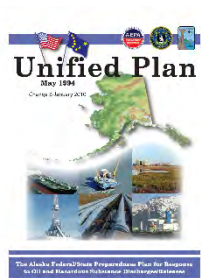


Figure 11. UCS Operations Staff Depicting Integration of State of Alaska (SOA) Task Forces and Geographic Divisions
